

SEARLES CHAPEL USE POLICIES:

- A) When the Searles Chapel is used for meetings of official Town boards, committees and commissions, a designated person shall be responsible for signing the key out from the Selectmen’s Office, and returning the key on the next business day.
- B) The Selectmen’s Office shall give the temporary alarm code for the day or time of the designated meeting.
- C) Reservations for town boards, committees and commissions shall be done on a first come, first served basis.
- D) Income producing rentals shall have priority over optional arrangements for town related meetings.
- E) The following groups shall be allowed to use the Searles Chapel for regular meetings, free of charge, and shall not be required to have the presence of the Designated Town Representative. The Board of Selectmen may add or delete names from this list from time to time.
