To the residents of Meetinghouse Road, Pilgrim Road and Easy Street, this letter is to inform you of upcoming road work that is scheduled to begin as of mid-August 2010 and continue into September 2010. The work will consist of reclaiming portions of Meetinghouse Road, then fine grading of the gravel base and then the installation of new asphalts. After the finder course of pavement, all basins and/or driveway adjustments will be made. Once this is complete the finish layer will be applied and then shoulder shimming will be completed either through loaming and seeding or graveling as appropriate. We, in general, will be doing paving work, some drainage work and adding some gravels to the roadbed, as well as other minor corrections to the existing roadbed. We will endeavor to keep one lane open at all times for residents to get in and out, however, there may be times when the road will be closed for brief periods to move equipment into place. We hope to keep problems to a minimum and expect the work to be completed within a one month period. The actual work on the road should only be a matter of several days. The work will begin at Route 111 and end just beyond Easy Street. We are hopeful when the project is complete it will create a safer travel way for all who use these roads on a daily basis.

Prior to any of this work, the highway department or its subcontractors will be in the work areas to complete cleanup from the ice or wind storms. Included will be brush removal, removal of any hanging limbs and any necessary tree removal.
